**RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Provide transportation for the Adult Day Centre
- Transport Corporate Volunteers to and from the Agency
- Pick up meals at food source as required
- Assist clients in and out of vehicle when necessary
- Deliver Meals on Wheels to Agency clients
- Provide supplementary driving duties as required
- Report to supervisor immediately of all vehicle maintenance problems
- Complete Vehicle Check-List form on a daily basis
- Clean the interior buses at the end of each shift
- Ensure that vehicles are properly parked, cleaned, secured and fuelled on a daily basis
- Attend monthly staff meeting and other agency meetings as required

- Must be 25 years of age or older and have a clean and recent driver's abstract
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Ability to work independently and part of team
- Knowledge of downtown city streets
