



Position Title: [Hygiene Kit Collection & Assembly – Corporate Volunteer Opportunity](#)
Reports to: Housing Services

SUMMARY: Volunteer teams collect travel-size hygiene products for distribution to guests of Dixon Hall's shelters and to participants in the various Housing and Case Management programs. *Minimum number of kits: 100; minimum number of items per kit: five.*

PROGRAM NEED: Our Housing Services programs are in need of travel-size hygiene products for both men and women. Products need to be packed in re-sealable bags for distribution.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Volunteer teams either raise funds for, or collect travel-sized hygiene products for men and women. Teams then assemble kits at their office with representation from a representative from Dixon Hall's Housing Services program who will provide an overview of the program showing how your team's volunteer work is supporting those who are vulnerably housed in the City of Toronto. The team will then deliver the kits to Dixon Hall and be provided with a tour of the shelter space. The tour MAY need to take place on a day different than kit assembly.

HYGIENE KIT SUGGESTIONS (travel-size bottles):

- Toothpaste, toothbrush and floss
- Shampoo and conditioner
- Shaving cream and razor
- Sunscreen
- Foot/body powder
- Hand/body cream (unscented)
- Shower gel and/or bar soap
- Hair styling tools: comb, brush, hair elastics, hair clips
- Hand sanitizing gel
- Band-Aids and antibiotic ointment
- Lip balm

BENEFITS TO YOU:

- Provide necessities of daily living to those on fixed incomes and/or without financial means
- Participate in a social event with co-workers
- Gain a better understanding of the issues around precarious housing in Toronto
