Music For Life is the annual benefit and gala dinner for Dixon Hall Music School. Taking place on November 12, 2026, at the Four Seasons Hotel Toronto, this year we celebrate 48 years of providing an accessible, creative home for children and youth.

This approach, coupled with rigorous yet fun learning experiences, promotes high retention and attendance rates across our student body. 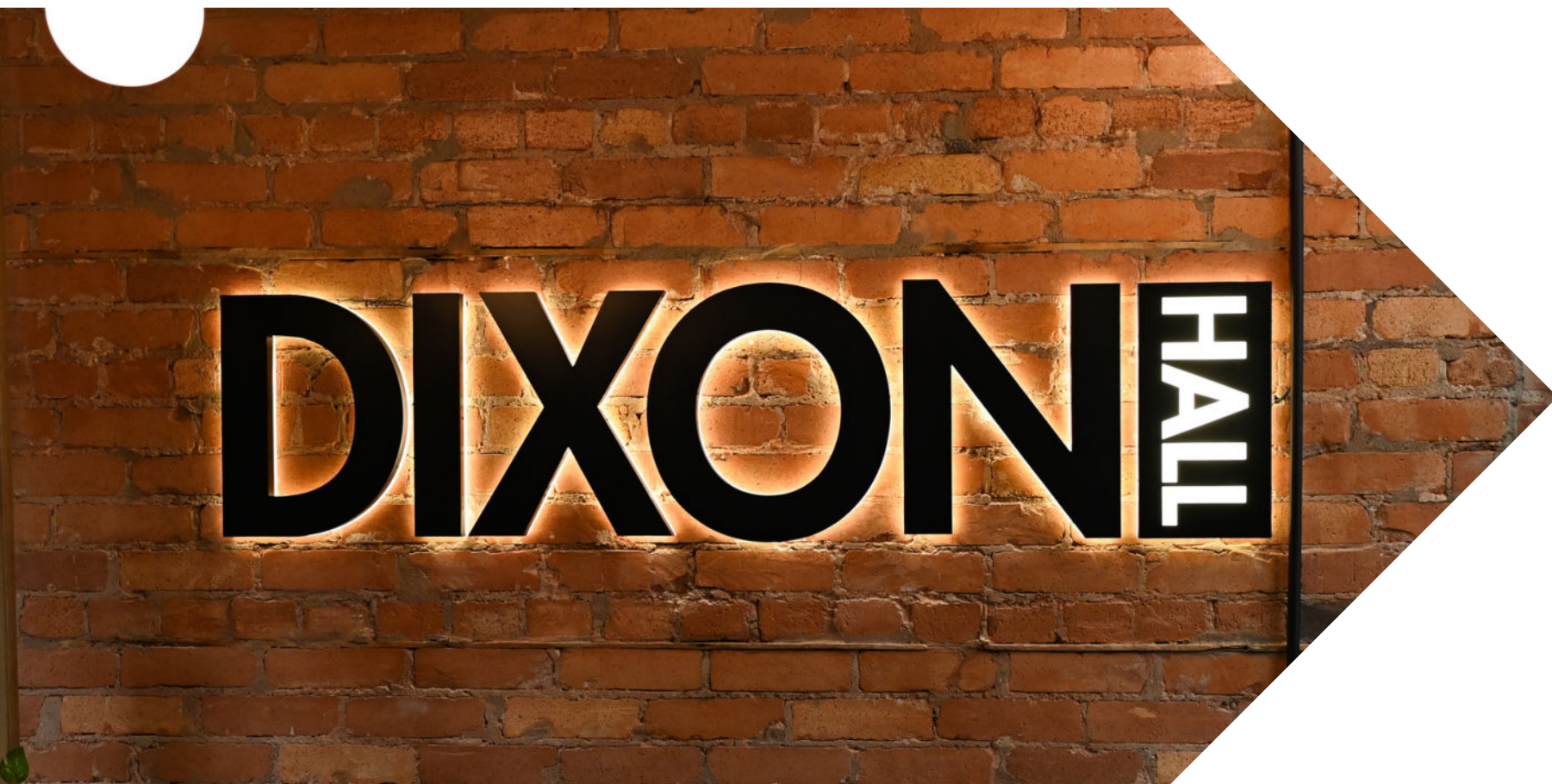
